Having the luxury of pipeline expertise within our board of supervisors gives us a unique position as it relates to the Mariner East project.

Throughout construction of this project, Sunoco Pipeline has been a good company neighbor. This started well before construction, when representatives from the company met with our township to talk about a variety of preconstruction topics. They showed us where the proposed route would be going, safety measures the company was taking, state and federal regulatory outfits overseeing the project and where the labor would be pulled from, and they talked about timelines. All of these subjects were communicated with the public again at community open houses.

As the project started and progressed, the Sunoco Pipeline people frequently provided real-time updates to our members. They've also provided us with a monthly construction progress newsletter that is handy with stakeholder interaction. Also, whenever we have run into a landowner question, they've always responded quickly.

They've shown their commitment to the township with sponsorship of our annual Community Days event, emergency responder trainings and partnership with Jackson Township's newly constructed CPV Fairview power plant. These are benefits that go beyond the mammoth \$9 billion capital investment put forth by the company.

Yes, it makes sense to scrutinize and prioritize safety, but this is starting to feel like regulatory overkill. We ask that the PUC make a conscious effort to expedite this process.
